The undersigned hereby applies for permission to condition seed for certification and agrees to the terms below:

- 1. Responsibility is assumed by the conditioner for maintaining identity of seed lots eligible for certification upon delivery of seed to their conditioning plant.
2. All conditioning (including blending, cleaning, treating, inoculating, and repackaging for any other purpose) must be approved and/or supervised by the Agricultural Commissioner.
3. Seed for certification must be handled at all times in such manner as to maintain identity, prevent mixture, and keep individual lots uniform throughout.
4. Complete, accurate records must be kept of all operations involving certified seed and shall be made available to the CCIA upon request.
5. Conditioner will request required analysis when submitting a seed sample of correct size (see individual crop standards) to a recognized seed laboratory for testing.
6. Certification may be maintained on a lot of seed only as long as subsequent tests for labeling data indicate that the seed meets or exceeds the standard (see individual crop standards).
7. The conditioner will comply with the standards, rules and regulations for certified seed, and cooperate fully with the Agricultural Commissioner and with the CCIA.
8. Conditioner accepts responsibility for payment of certification fees. Conditioner will be invoiced by the CCIA monthly. These fees must be paid promptly (within 30 days upon receipt of statement).
9. Conditioner agrees to allow the CCIA to post conditioner contact information on the CCIA web site.
10. Failure to comply with the terms set forth herein shall cause revocation of approval by the CCIA.
